3. **How will you do it?** What are the *specific* strategies, objectives and activities you are interested in? What do you want your impact to be? Will that impact be felt beyond your experience in this internship? Why and how? (500 words)
4. **How will you measure results?** What will you measure to help you understand whether you are making progress or have succeeded? How will you know whether you need to adjust the program to better meet the need? (250 words)
